

6:00am

Starting at the sea end of the wharf – the procession will head to the north-eastern side of the Orongo park led by two missionaries holding an archaic Bible

People chanting and drums beating as they follow the Bible heading towards Orongo Park

Procession, chanting and drumming end when they arrive at the Commemorative Stone
